Airbnb	Airbnb allows people to list their homes for rent. Here, you can search to rent an entire home, just a room or even a shared room. Airbnb features reviews/ratings and in-depth descriptions of the units and offers filters like price, amenities and pet-friendly options to help make your search easier! Rentals tend to cost less the longer you stay, so keep this option in mind when you're on a longer assignment. Aya tip: Airbnb hosts can be a great resource to get acquainted with a new city.
AreaVibes	AreaVibes is a website with an interactive map that helps you find the best places to live all over the U.S. based on a rating system. Each neighborhood/city is ranked by amenities, cost of living, crime, education, employment, housing and weather — with 1 being the most favorable area to live and 50 being the least favorable.
Bring Fido	Got pets? Bring Fido assists in the search for pet-friendly options in the area of your choice. Various tabs at the top of the page help you search for pet-friendly lodging, airlines and restaurants.
Craigslist	Craigslist is a common resource for rental listings including homes, apartments and single rooms. They recently added a helpful map feature to aid in your search. Beware of Craigslist scams — they're out there! If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is.
ForRent.com	ForRent is similar to sites like Trulia and Realtor.com (see below) . This site is very user-friendly and includes floor plans as well as availability for all units. Follow the link, enter in your desired location and click Search!

Furnished Finder	Don't want to worry about furnishing a new place every time you move? Furnished Finder locates furnished options without paying markups, commissions or booking fees. This is a great option if you're looking for an "all-inclusive" option.
Hotpads	Hotpads features an interactive map that lets you search the entire city you're heading to. Just type in the city name and click on the icons you'd like more information about.
Neighborhood Scout	Want a quick overview of the city you plan to visit? Neighborhood Scout gives you a full description of any city, as well as its level of safety. All you have to do is enter an address!
PerkSpot	Visit this website to find Aya-exclusive discounts at a variety of hotel chains, including Extended Stay America and Choice Hotels. Simply create your account, select Categories, then Travel and search for the area where you're looking for a hotel.
Realtor.com	Realtor.com is a website (and user-friendly mobile app) that makes browsing rentals easy. You can download the realtor.com app in the app store, or head to the website, select Rent and enter a city.
Trulia	Trulia provides a way for you to see postings in the area and access contact information of the property owners. All you have to do is select Rent in the drop-down menu on the homepage, enter the area you're traveling to and click Search.
Vrbo	Vrbo is short for vacation rental by owner. This website allows homeowners to list their properties for rent all over the world. It specializes in vacation rentals, such as houses, apartments, condos, villas, etc. Like Airbnb, you can filter by budget, city and number of guests.
Walk Score	Walkscore is a website and mobile app that focuses on the walkability/bikeability of listings. You can plug in any address and it produces a description, walk-score and bike-score for that location. The higher the score, the easier it is to have a walking (or biking) lifestyle in that area.
Zillow	Zillow is another site to help you find rentals in your desired area. Select Rent on the homepage and enter the desired ZIP code. On the next page you can set filters like your budget, amenities, etc. The map feature is also a helpful way to find listings in a particular area — we know it's all about location, location, location!
